

A short biography of Angelica Lindén Hirschberg

Dr. Angelica Lindén Hirschberg is Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the Department of Women's and Children's Health, Karolinska Institutet, Stockholm, Sweden. She is Head of the Women's Health Research Unit and a Consultant Gynecologist in charge of Gynecological Endocrinology at the Karolinska University Hospital, Stockholm, Sweden. Her research is focused on gynecological endocrinology and reproductive and metabolic health in women including elite athletes. Professor Hirschberg is a fellow of the Endocrine Society and Androgen Excess and PCOS Society (AE-PCOS), a member of the board of the International Society of Gynecological Endocrinology (ISGE), President of the European Menopause and Andropause Society (EMAS), editor for the international journal Maturitas, and a member of the editorial board of Gynecological Endocrinology, Gynecological and Reproductive Endocrinology and Metabolism (GREM) and the Journal of Clinical Endocrinology and Metabolism (JCEM). She is also the official gynecologist of the Swedish Olympic Teams, medical advisor to World Athletics and the International Olympic Committee (IOC), and a board member of AntiDoping Sweden. Professor Hirschberg was awarded the 2016 Grand Prize in Sport Science. In 2009 Professor Hirschberg was appointed a Physician-in-Attendance to the Swedish Royal Family and she was awarded the King's Seraphim Medal, 8th size, in 2018.
